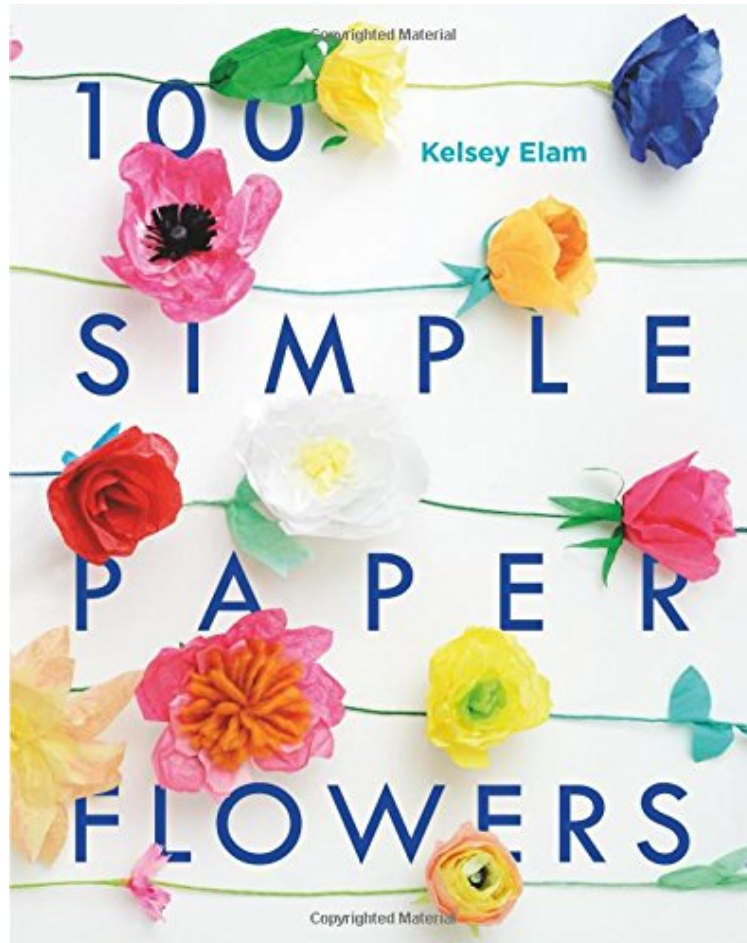

Arnold I like this book overall, but I do have a couple notes that might be useful for others looking to enjoy making paper flowers. First, there are a couple minor editing issues that might leave people confused: the instructions for the Rhododendron and Azalea are swapped (pages 12-13). The same is true for the Angel Cheeks Pom Peony (pg 14) and the Misaka Itoh Peony (pg 16). There are a huge variety of different flowers to make, including some that I have not seen in any other paper flower books. I also appreciate that the book includes ideas for a few projects using the flowers. The pictures are beautiful and the blooms are really lovely. I am a more experienced paper flower crafter, and found most of the techniques and methods familiar. I think that others with some experience will find this book easy to use. However, I don't know that the instructions and techniques are laid out in a way that is as easy for newer crafters to make sense of. The layout is not as intuitive and step-by-step as it could be. For beginners, I might recommend starting with Livia

Cetti's "Exquisite Book of Paper Flowers" to get more familiar with some basic techniques, and then use this book next. 1 of 1 people found the following review helpful.
