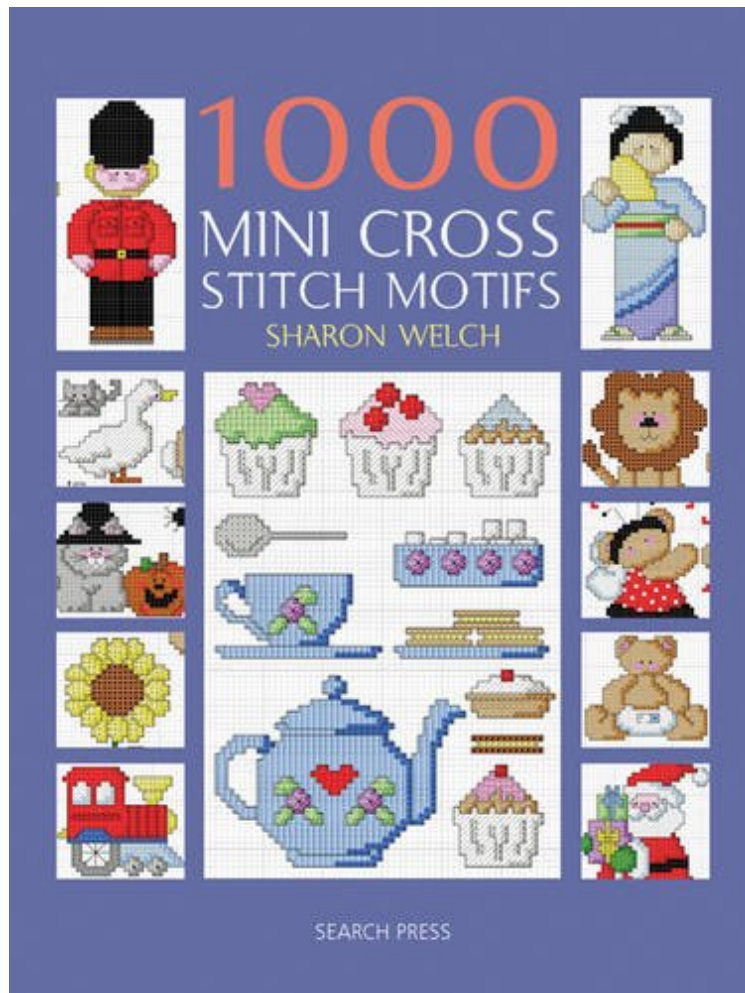

There are many truly mini cross stitch patterns that I can use to cross-stitch something fun, simple and quickly on 8" plain crocheted squares I make to donate to a charity for very special children. An 8" crochet square is approximately 25-27 stitches across and 30-32 stitches high - definitely not a large area and I do not necessarily want to cover the entire area due to time constraints. These patterns are in a variety of subjects, in different sizes and can be combined as you choose to create any type of cross-stitched picture you'd like. What I appreciate the most is the quality of the designs; the patterns look realistic and are easily identifiable which is a different style from a tapestry crochet book I purchased. The shading and detail in the designs makes these real little treasures. Worked on plastic canvas, the items make sturdy toys for children that are easy to take along in a car, etc. Stitched on cloth, they will brighten anyone's day. I am starting with the a set of animals that will decorate a holiday wreath. Because the designs are simple, it is easy to adapt them to give a personal touch. This book is a real steal at the price, and because it is sturdy and of compact size, it is easy to carry along in your project bag.

It is brimming over with motifs for mini projects, gifts and samplers. The charted designs are grouped into popular themes offering ideas for all occasions including weddings, birthdays, Christmas and Easter. The main body of the book focuses entirely on these motifs, and stitchers can mix and match designs, choosing from a wonderful selection of charming, whimsical and appealing patterns, borders and images. Also, there is a helpful introduction, which includes advice on materials, techniques and how to start, and worked examples show some of the motifs as samplers and finished pieces. Mini motifs are quick to stitch and cross stitch is an easy to learn technique, so beginners have all they need within these pages to create something special, and more experienced stitchers will love the wonderful variety of subjects, which include flowers, animals, teatime treats, travel, little people, houses and much more.

Motifs are useful to embellish cards and children's blankets. You can get special aida which you sew on to another fabric while you cross stitch which then dissolves in water. There are twelve introductory pages before the motifs on: stitches, framing, using the charts, sizing your design and preparing the fabric.
