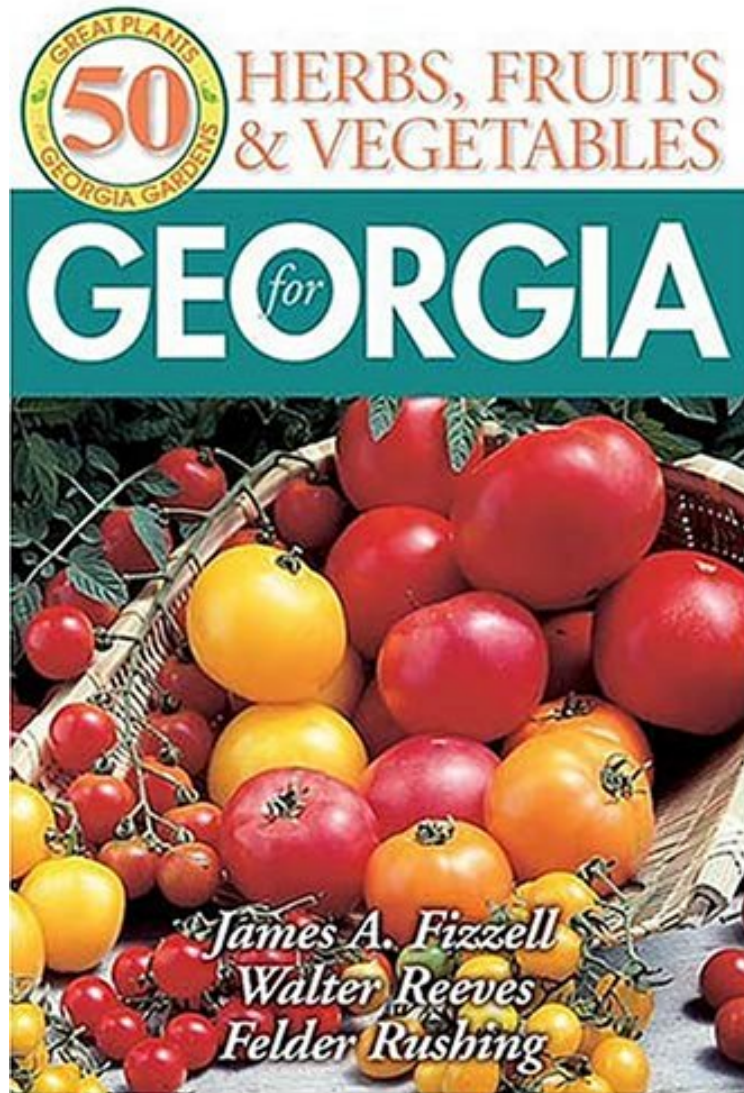

You get planting, watering, and fertilizing tips on 14 herbs, 26 veggies, and 10 fruits that grow fairly well in Georgia. The pictures are nice, and the planting tips are, for the most part, accurate. I took issue with some of the entries, though. For example, the section on apples failed to discuss some of the better varieties

now on the market, and the section on asparagus failed to discuss how seriously you need to amend the soil to get a decent crop. The info in this book is about what you'd get on the backs of good seed packets, without having to buy the seeds.
