I'd say I've stitched 1/3 to 1/2 of the designs in this book, and was pleased with every single one of them!I made Christmas ornaments using metallic gold perforated paper, and parchment-colored perforated paper as well. I also used perforated plastic, and aida cloth; all looked excellent, although the light green perforated plastic was my least favorite. I backed these in red felt for the most part, using fray-check or the like on the edges of the aida cloth.For the ornaments I gave as gifts (generally the larger designs in this book, such as a heart shape filled with Santa peering out from within it), the reception was any variation of, "Wow, THANK you; I love it! This looks so marvelous!" I don't say this to say that my stitching skills are all that, but rather that the designs are great for gifts, for decorating the tree, packages, or elsewhere around the holiday home, or,, I'm sure stitched on other applications such as towels, coasters, etc.I can't say I LOVE all 50 designs, but who would? I love many of them, and really appreciate the variety of types, shapes, and styles of Santa motifs provided; that, combined with the ease of use of the patterns and Sam Hawkins' nice designs are why I bought the book.Highly recommended!
