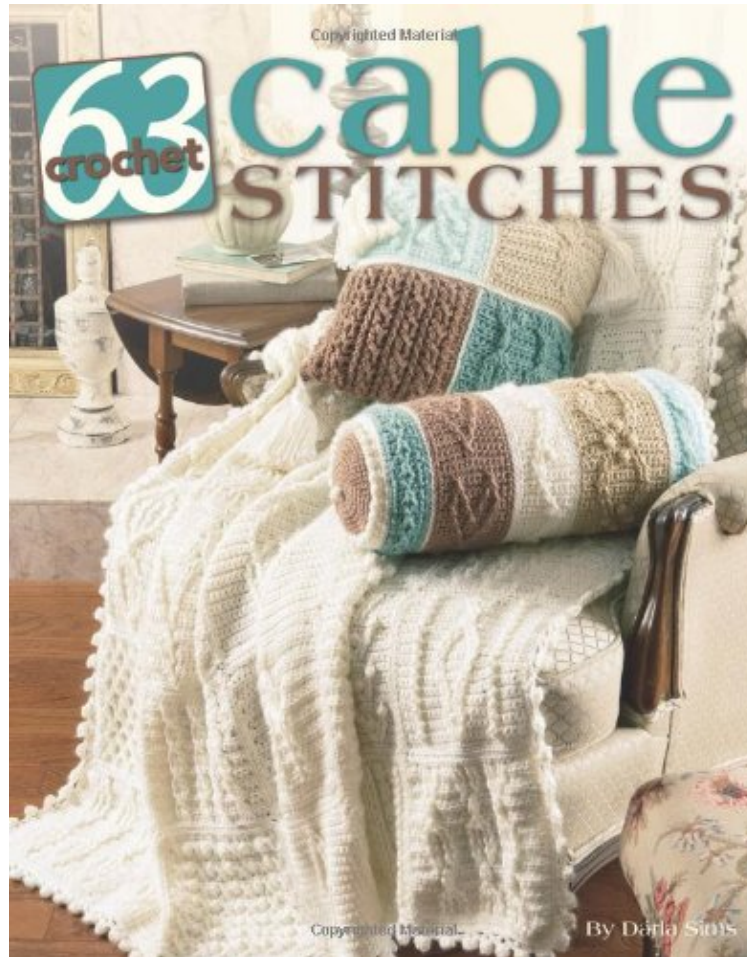

I figured the rest would be as well displayed. All swatch photos are at the beginning of the book and numbered. There are not photos of the stitches with the actual instructions. I really don't care for the layout of the book. It's nice to have the photo of the swatch right next to the instructions so you can look at it as you work if needed. I am an experienced crocheter, and love the cable look, and these patterns totally absorb my attention and let me block out anything that is worrying me! They are definitely intermediate level directions, and I have come close

to having my spirit broken by them, but not quite! I love a challenge, and these are perfect for me. I probably won't make the afghan with 63 squares, but maybe 33 or 23. They are very pretty and very good cable practice, but buy the printed book, not the kindle one, as there have been problems reported with that.
