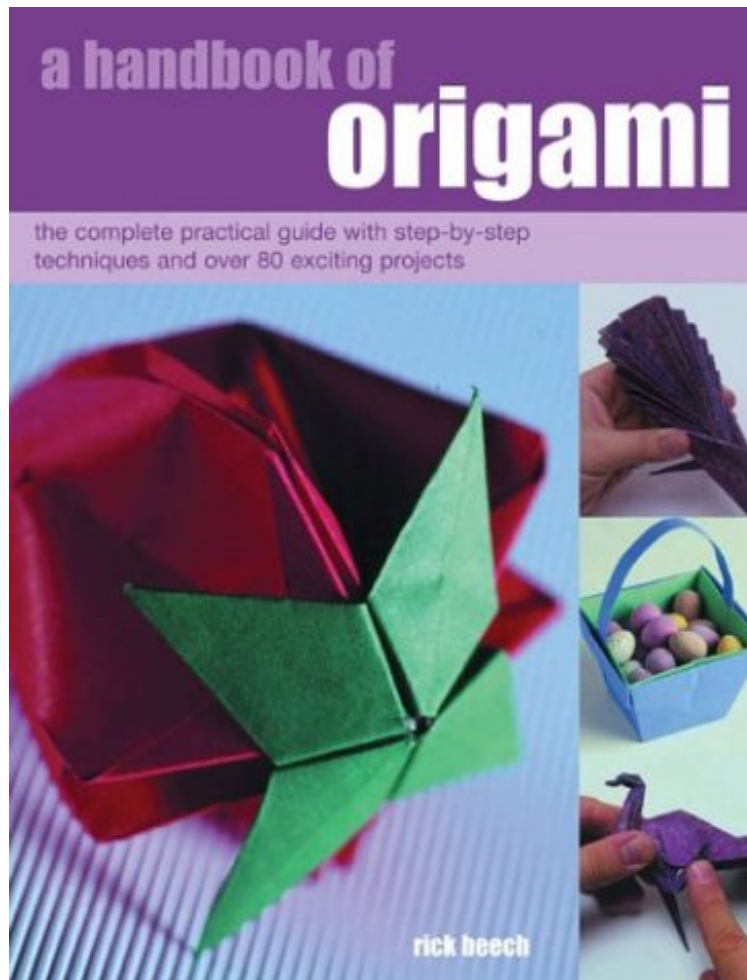

The "better" models are the modular origamis but the instructions are not very clear and the pictures have funny angles and lights... I figured them out because Ive been folding for a while but if I were just

starting, I would've burned this book down. If you were a beginner, it COULD be a good book if it weren't because of the internet, but you can find most models online. I honestly wouldn't recommend it. Unless you have been folding for a while, you are going to get lost and miss steps. And if you have been folding for a while, you will see that only 2 or 3 models are worth your time (which is pretty bad for a whole book).
