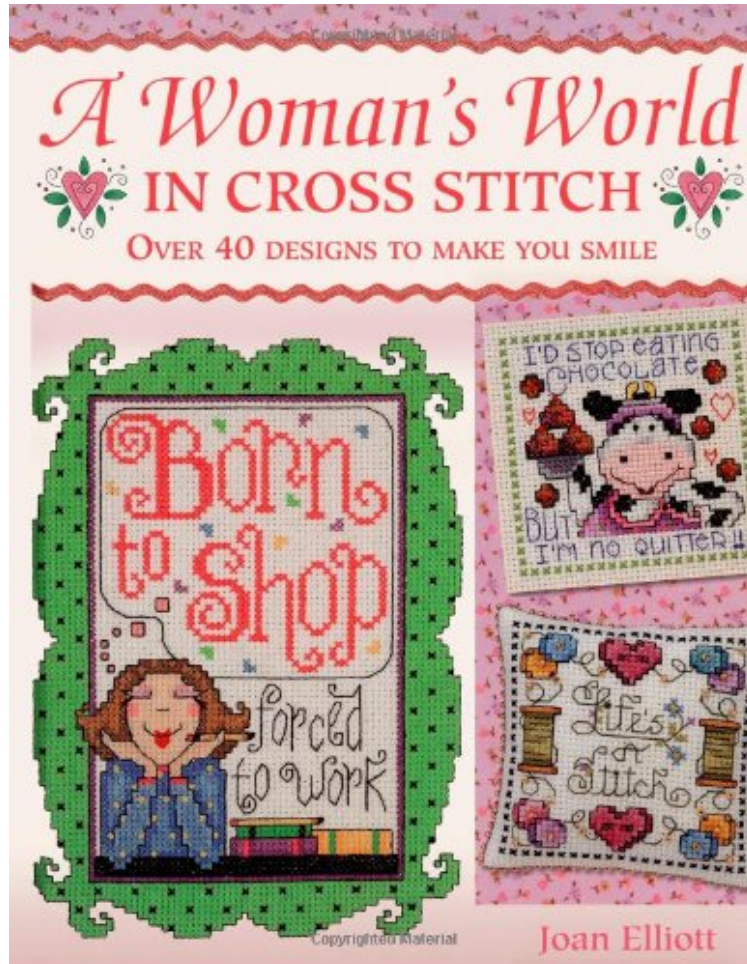

It is hard to see from the cover that the book has such wonderful and detailed patterns. There is a really lovely Victorian Ladies floral sampler, too.I almost gave this a miss, based on the cover. I didn't want to buy a book of only

small patterns. I saw an excerpt of the Sea Goddess in a British cross stitch magazine and decided that cost effectiveness would be to buy this book instead. Once I received it and saw the variety of the size and types of patterns, I was very glad to have bought it.
