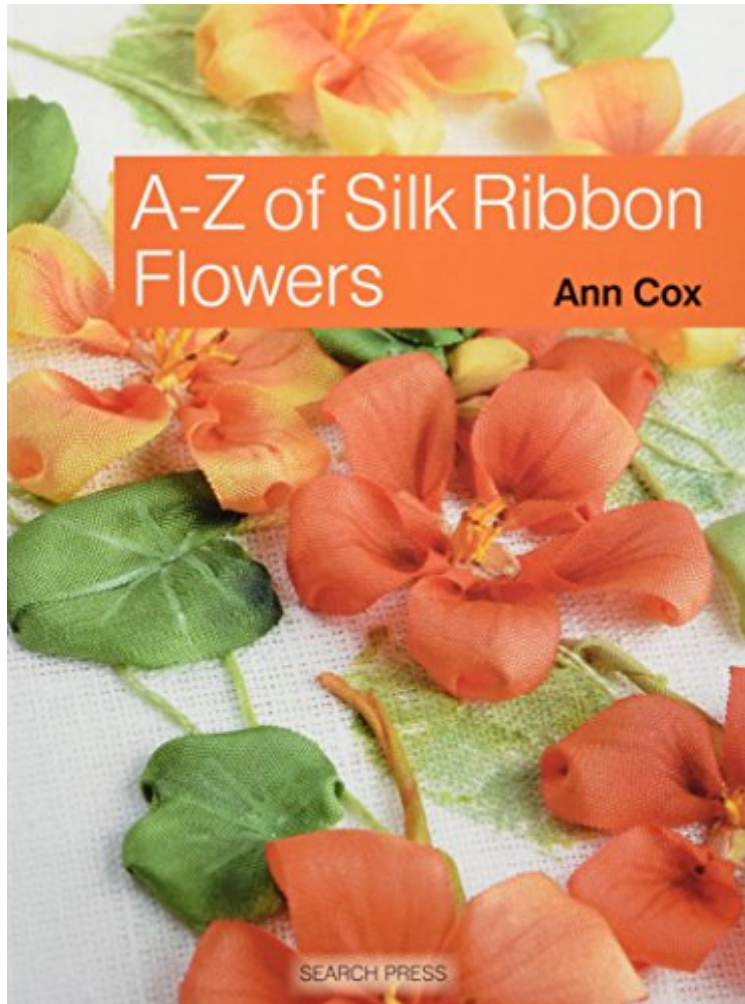

beginner, intermediate and advance skill levels. Each project is shown in actual size with a few close-up shots. The instructions are clear and there is plenty of room to express your own creativity and still get beautiful results. My only complaint is that the templates in the book are all half size (or smaller) which means you have to copy them at 200%. This makes it difficult to trace the designs. Perfect for beginners, this project guide features step-by-step instructions and stunning close-up photography for more than 30 flower designs in a wide variety of styles. A comprehensive tutorial on techniques covers all of the basic skills needed to make beautiful ribbon flowers, including how to handle and work with ribbon, transfer a design to fabric using a template, and paint ribbons and backgrounds to achieve different effects. Each design includes a template and diagrams while inspirational ideas for variations on the main design expand the range and style of the projects. Information on ribbon stitches and gathering techniques and types of materials rounds out this useful reference.
