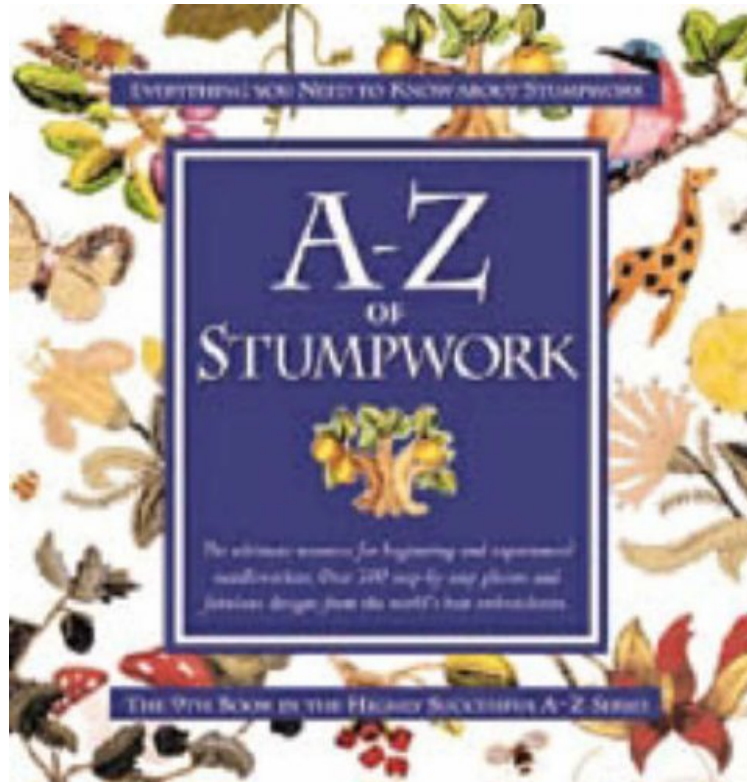

By Julesinrose I was expecting only a few projects at the back of this book, and was disappointed to discover that only a third of this slim volume contained detailed step-by-step stitch diagrams. The directions and photographs are excellent, with clear photographs and writing. However, the patterns aren't general enough (such as "flower shapes" or "leaf shapes") to be all that useful for reference. Some of stitching in the patterns isn't of the quality that inspires me; for that, I'd recommend any of Jane Nicholas' books. However, I'm glad I purchased this book, at a discounted price, for what it does offer. It's a good starting place for a beginner in stump work who already knows general embroidery stitches.
