It includes 20 landscapes plus several borders, a fancy alphabet, DMC SILK and Paternayan wool conversion chart (I'd just use DMC floss) and instructions on cross stitch. This book was published in 1976 and with the Bicentennial clearly in mind, the landscapes are mostly of the colonial era sites, the US Capitol, a rural landscape, a map of the 48 states, Mt. Vernon, etc. See the Images I uploaded above. I included the half page of NYC to show the Twin Towers...they had just been built in 1975 and so were fresh and new when this book came out...\*sigh\*These patterns are a little too simplistic for me but they're well-laid out and maybe would look best on a fine count linen over one thread, there being no partial stitches. The only outlining is around each letter of the alphabet.I would have given this book 2 or 3 stars based on my taste for the projects.
