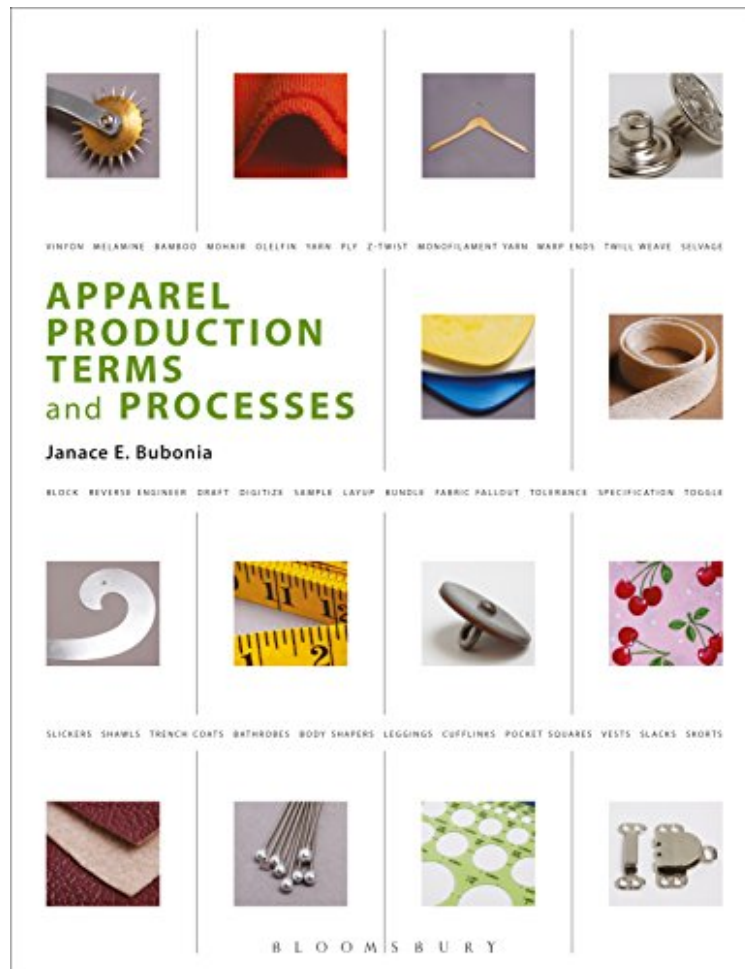


Apparel Production Terms and Processes
