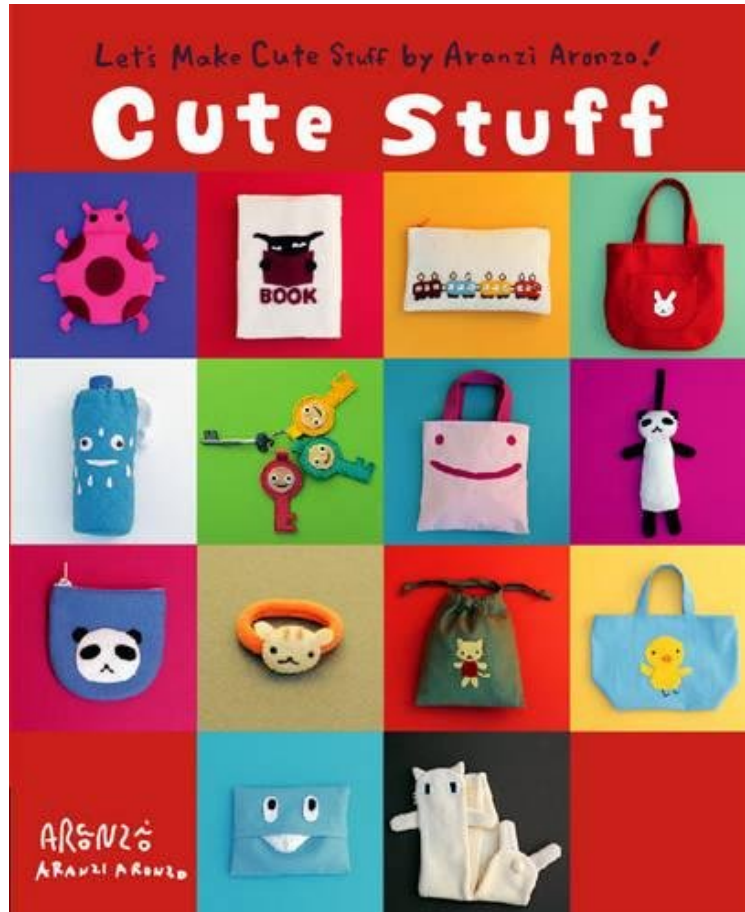

Upon reading the book it is clear to see (which I should have been more obvious of) that it is cute things. But the cute things seem to be for younger crafters, not so adult-ish. (the few items I saw before buying was tissue case and bottle holder which gave me the impression of a few more cute adult items. So though all is very cute only a handful of the items I will be making including Bottle holder, key chain, tissue case, pencil holder, pouch, embroidery napkins. Though the "cutness" is a little too much for me, they do show you how to make useful items such as napsacks and grocery bags so if you take out some of the cute can work for anyone.
