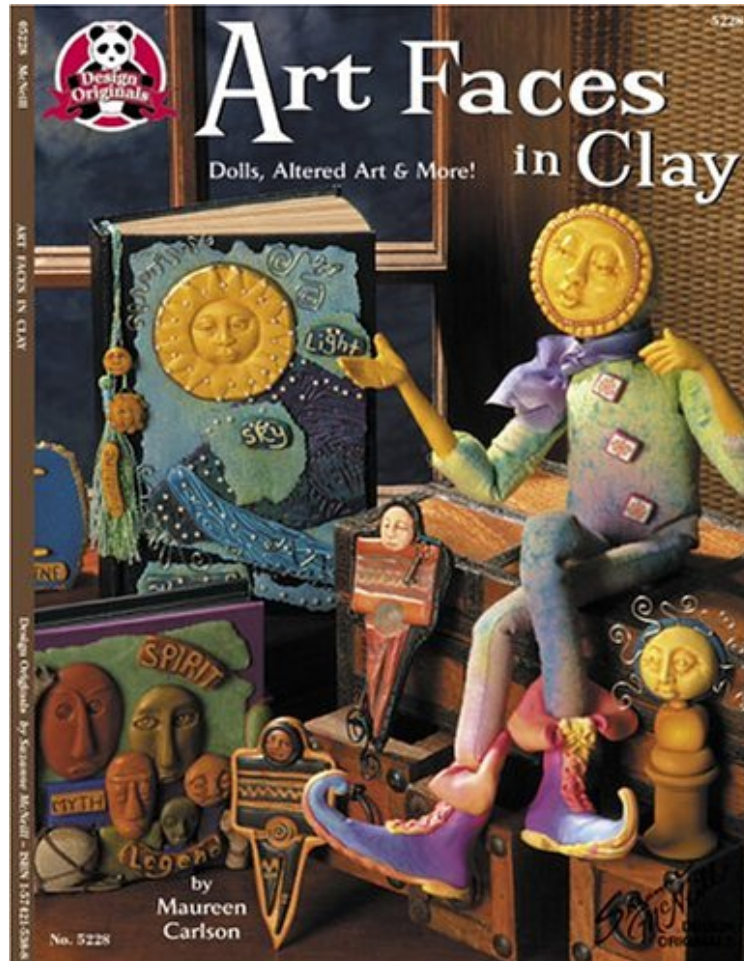

Interesting Approach to DollsBy rose thymeThis book reflects a certain style of polymer clay face dolls. When doing research, I often get books that explain processes that I may not use myself. I have not molded faces or worked that much in polymer clay. I do feel that the instructions in this book and the variety of dolls produced is good. There are techniques that could be applied to other mixed media and doll

making, so this is valid and useful. It is not necessary to adhere to a particular style to get instruction from the content of the book, and the techniques contained are covered pretty well. 20 of 20 people found the following review helpful.
