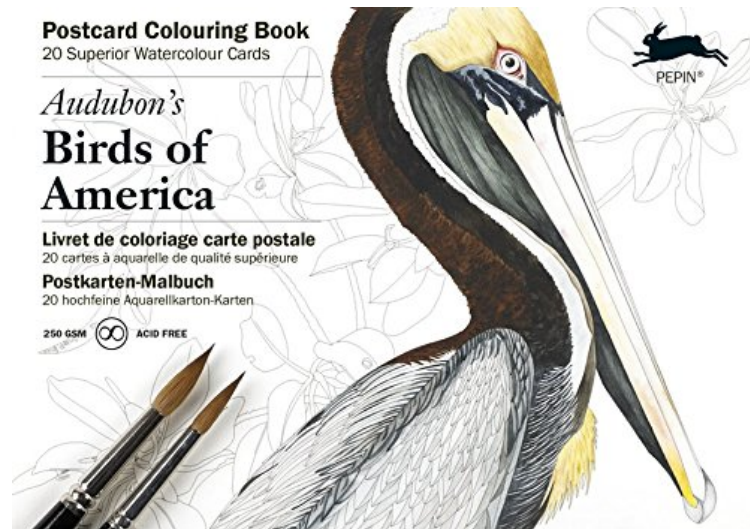

Lines delineating color areas and the bird's anatomy are light gray but very easy to see. You'll probably have to use very small brushes with watercolors to achieve the detail shown on the cover. I am seeing this problem in general, in these postcard books (though the Van Gogh postcards book is a bit better, with the William Morris being the worst of the bunch, as far as sizing goes only--the art, like that of all of the pepin books, is quite nice). pepin has produced some lovely full sized coloring books, but the printing work of their postcard sized books does not seem to have been checked by the publisher. there will be a number of images in this book that you will be able to color, with a bit of work and the proper tools, but I do not recommend any of these postcard books, in general, to anyone with vision problems, which I am currently finding myself facing. pepin's full size coloring books are lovely to work in, and I recommend them without reservation. I own Still Life Bouquets, of which I ordered a second copy for a friend, as well as the Japanese and Turkish Designs books. I recommend them all, specially the Still Life Bouquet book.
