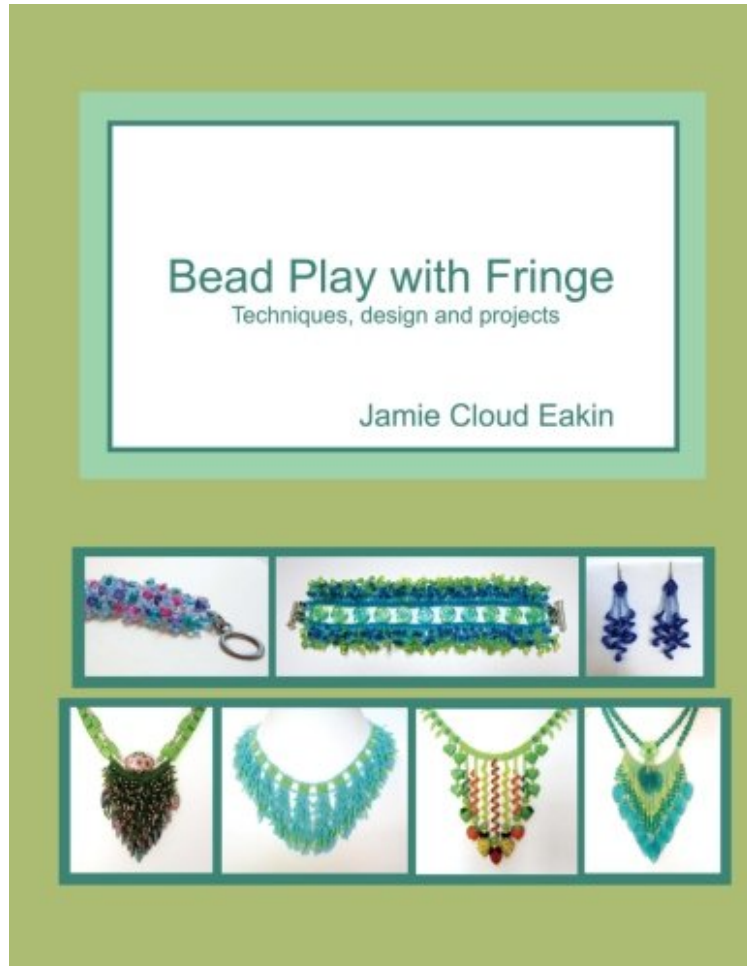

It is nice to have all of these techniques in one place. This is especially useful for the creative beader looking for finishing ideas all in one place. The book is divided into sections of each specific technique, which also make it easy to maneuver. The written instructions and graphed pattern examples seem very easy to follow and well written, although the photography is a bit blurry and lacking in detail (paper does not have a glossy finish, instead, a matte finish). This could make it difficult for the visual beader who is use to counting beads in a photograph, or using the photograph as reference in completing patterns.
