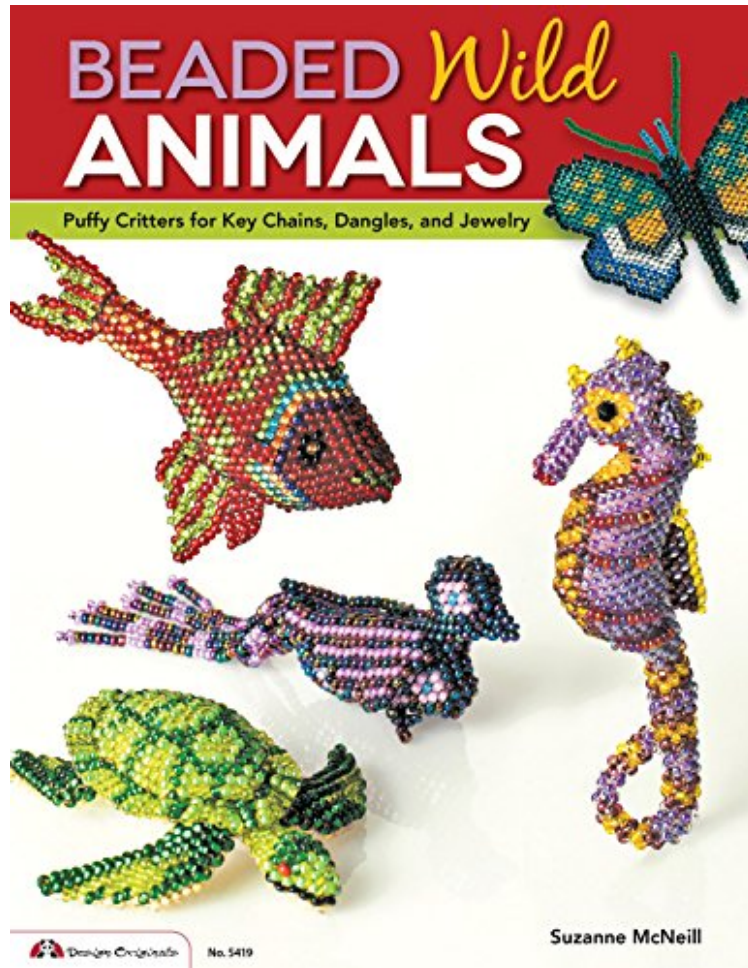

and odd peyote stitch are given at the beginning of the book, but in the patterns themselves the instructions are merely "weave body." The pattern instructions do not even indicate whether you are doing an even or odd count. There are beading charts, but there again, unless you are very comfortable reading basic charts, they aren't very helpful. If you've looked at patterns on Pinterest, you've probably noticed many of them include stitching directions for your thread or have numbered the beads.
