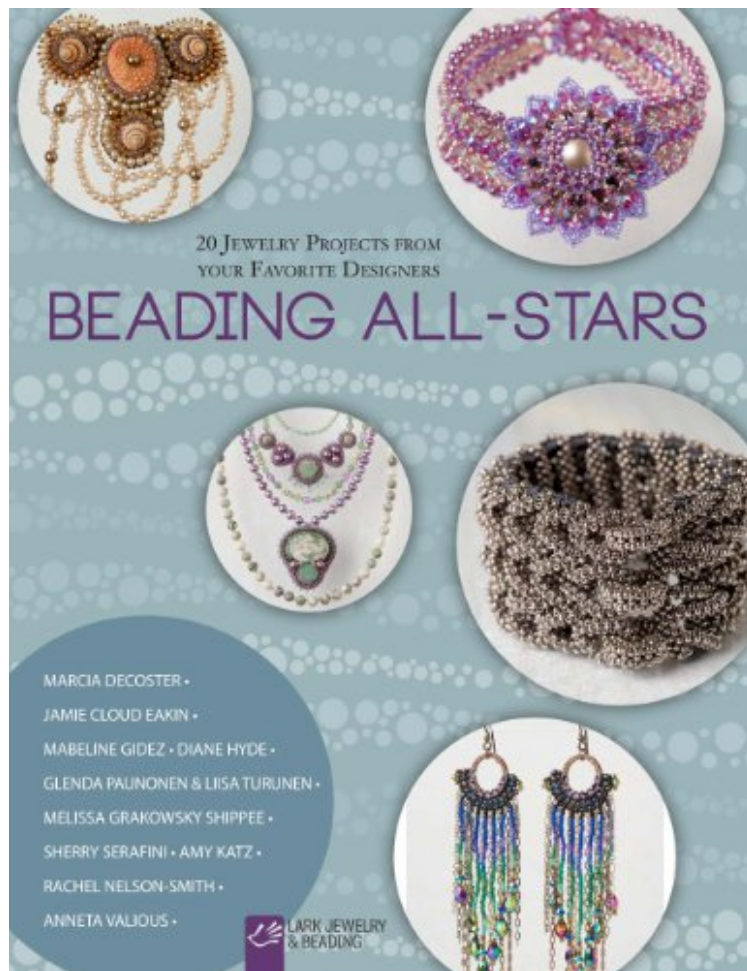

(I'm lying.)But you will be able to make these glorious items, with the generous help provided by this book. The written directions are perfect for a written oriented person like me, and there are incredible pictures showing how each step is supposed to work. If you are more

than a beginner, this book is for you. How do you know? My definition is that you know the basics of off-loom stitchery, and the section of every bead book telling you how to use each stitch and what bead is what just annoys you, you are more than a beginner. Do you have definite preferences for Japanese seed beads over Czech seed beads (or vice-versa)? Do you prefer one brand of Japanese seed bead over another, and prefer something different than Miyuki Delicas? Then you're probably an Intermediate, and will have fun making these projects. If you find the projects too easy, you're probably one of the authors and you should send me a signed copy. :-) But really, the projects are wonderful, can easily be changed from formal to casual with a quick switch of bead colors, and you'll soon find yourself changing thread paths every so slightly, just to see what happens.
