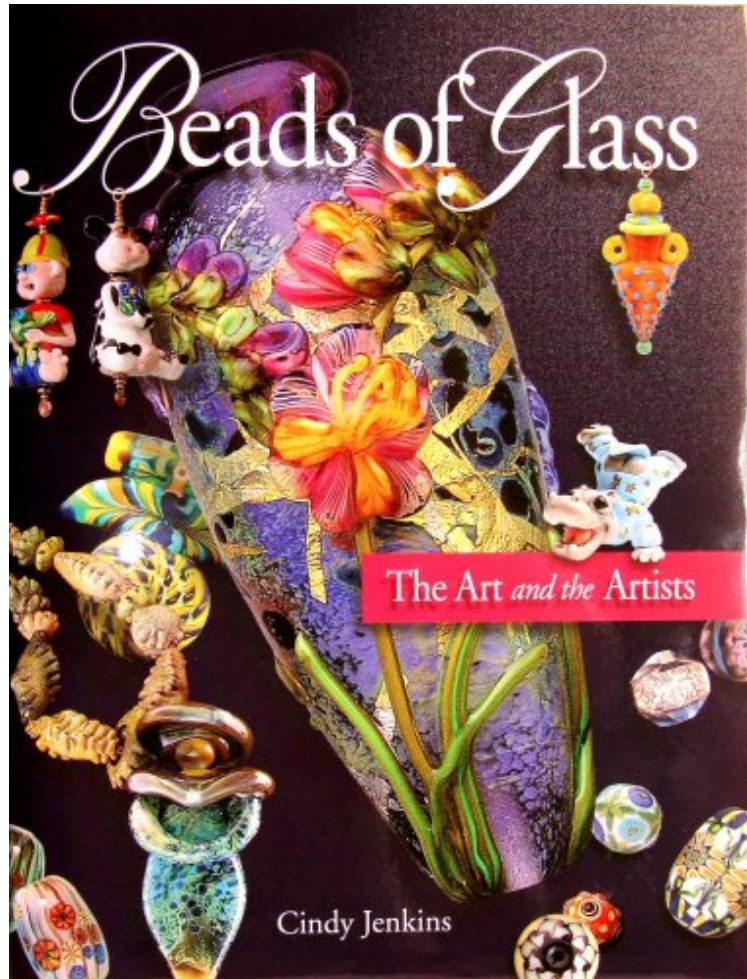

It includes three sections, followed by a glossary and several indices.This book includes three major sections. The first is a dozen pages of beads created by the artists in the book. A legend for these pages appears at the back to identify each bead and its maker. The overall effect of these pages is remarkable.The second section presents each artist on a page giving a brief resume, a quote and several beads of the artist's making, usually including the bead(s) they are most famous for.The third section shows lampwork techniques in beautiful still photography, by the lampwork artists included in the book. These include basic techniques and more advanced ones, including come of the artists' most important techniques, which is very generous.If you are interested in who makes these beautiful works of art, these are some of the best and

their creations. If you want an idea of how they are made, you will find the how-to section informative.
