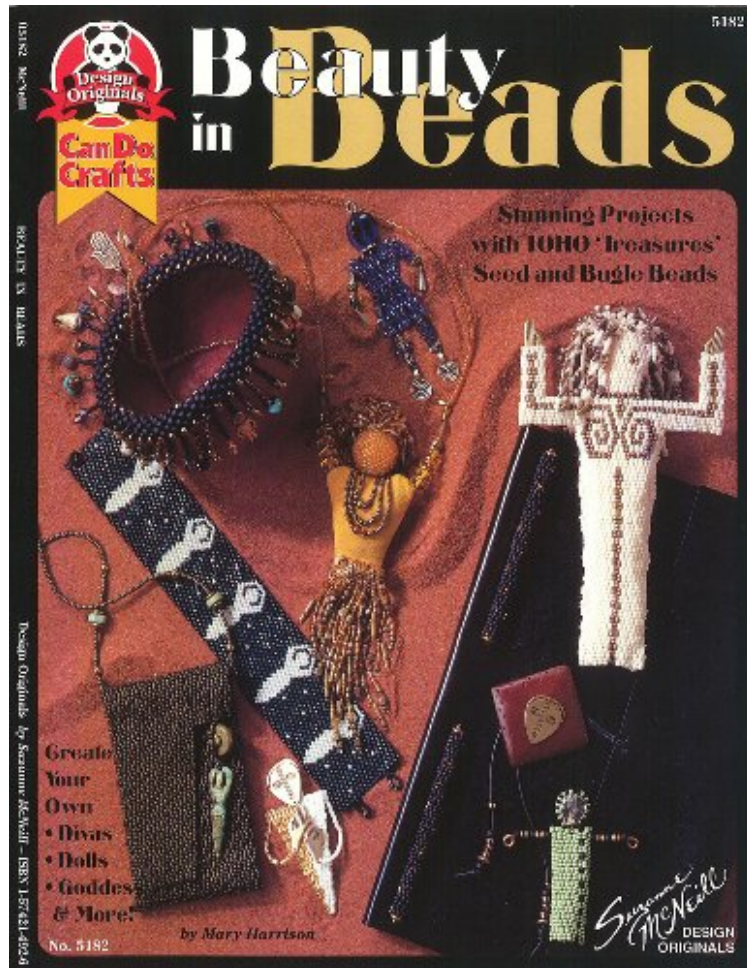

If I were re-naming this book as a very accurate description of these patterns, it would be titled "Beading the Goddess". I would advise any potential buyer to look very carefully at the cover of this collection. With all but a couple of omissions, (a beaded gourd and an interesting beaded tassel necklace), the cover is exactly the content of this pattern book.If you are interested in the goddess theme and a new beader, this book goes through a lot of technical technique for the beginner. The variation is also enough to inspire the experienced beader, but by this time, most of the

older with experience crowd have probably done a lot of this style in the later 90's. Personally, I bought this collection because I was interested in the peyote stitched goddess bracelet that was on the cover, hoping that it was 2 drop or 3 peyote. It's not, but there are some other variations of the goddess theme throughout this collection with 2 drop peyote. For me, it was nice to be reminded of some techniques I'd forgotten I'd known about. Overall it's a nice pattern book of goddess themed off loom beading (bead woven). Included are Delica and Toho Treasures color numbers, 10 patterns with variations, predominant goddess theme.

Beautiful TOHO beads are the basis of dozens of stunning projects.
