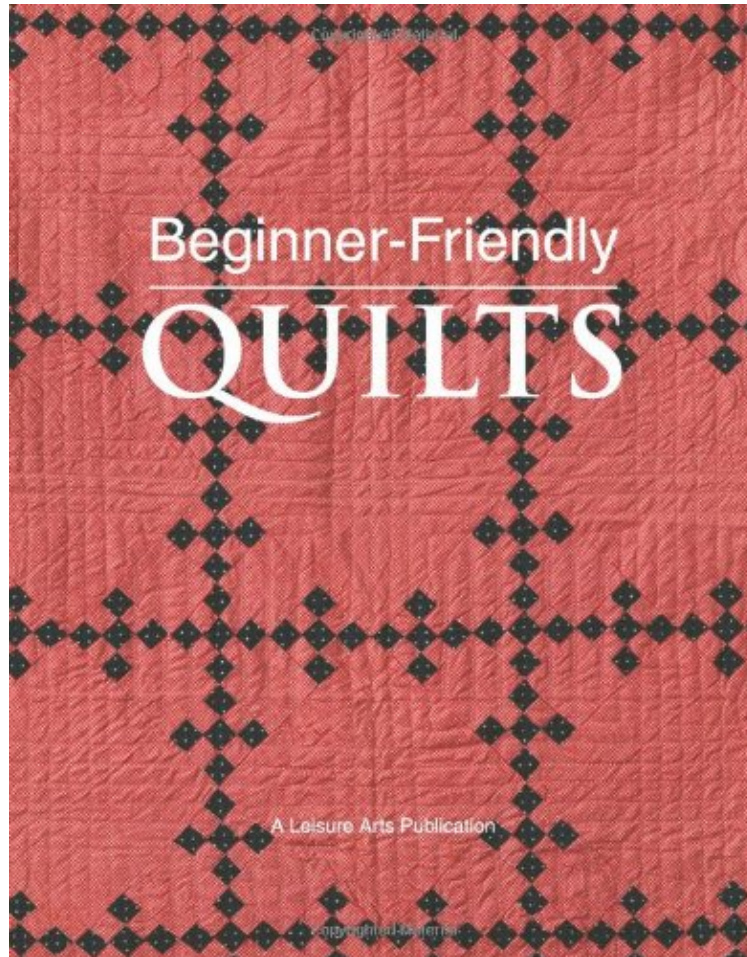

I bought it to have patterns to share with new quilters or that might make up quickly if I needed something relatively quickly to give someone. It does have patterns that use straight seams and avoid things like Y seams and curves but some do have a lot of pieces and would not be FAST to make, although still not difficult. It does give detailed directions for things like making and using strip sets, how to make pairs of triangles, how to set blocks on point, etc. which should also help beginners. It also gives ideas for how to quilt the quilt for those that want to try something more custom than either stitch in the ditch or an edge to edge pattern. For patterns that make up quickly, I'd go with looking on Google or Pinterest for "3 yard quilts" (for baby quilts and small throws) and "5 yard quilts" (for regular throws or ideas of things that could be extended for bed size quilts). People who like this but want even more instructions about the hows and whys of basic quilting skills, might also like Harriet Hargrove's "Quilters

Academy" series. This book is similar to her Freshman and Sophomore ones but with more patterns and less instruction. 0 of 0 people found the following review helpful. Love This Book By Sharon M.
