There isn't enough, in my opinion, drawn or photographed instruction on how to work the stitches. I am more of a visual learner and need more than a chart and written instruction. I need to see the hands doing the stitches so I can copy them. There are a lot of Youtube.com videos about needlework now. Ahh yes to be old enough to have slowed down to watch them and young enough to still do the work.This book was a bit on the expensive side, however I will be adding it to my library because knitting
