The photos are gorgeous! Again you get the symbols, photos, written instructions, and diagrams. But this book is about construction. ALL about construction. Top-down, one piece, bottom up, rounds, rows, granny motifs and a section on "unique construction". Some of her combinations are truly inspired, like a lace top with a heavy cowl collar worked as granny motifs, then joined. My favorite has to be the "Burnt Plaid Dress" worked from the bottom up to the shoulders. Yes, I said plaid.Tips throughout, symbols, abbreviations and illustrations, written stitch directions all handily placed at the book. Although not a true step-by-step for designing from scratch, this book does have a lot of hints and tricks, and provides several attractive sweaters for you to customize and tweak to fit you perfectly.
