The book has project of all levels, but the majority of them seem to be beginner and intermediate.Yarn Used: This book did a great job of including projects from each yarn weight category. The patterns themselves only list the weight yarn used for the project, not the brand, but the back of the book does include a section that tells you what kind of yarn was used for each project. The only downfall I noticed is that the back of the book lists what kinds of yarns were used, but it doesnt tell you what weight the brand is. I didnt recognize all the brands, so I had to go back and look to see what weight it was. Not a huge deal, I think it just may have been more convenient to have all that info in the same place.First Impression: Lots of color!Review: Not only are there over 30 patterns in this book, but by changing your color options it makes endless possibilities! While there are a few exceptions (ex: afghans) the

majority of the projects will work up quickly.
