There's even a handy wool conversion chart in the back of the book. Not every design is charted in this book. Some of the designs, such as the Rabbit and Meadow Garden, are charted in other books published by Ehrman Needlepoint, such as Birds and Beasts. Medieval Needlepoint was also published in the UK as Flowers, Birds and Unicorns. So be careful not to order the same book twice! Over the years I've made five of the designs in this book and the finished products are some of my favorite pieces. I hope you will enjoy this book as much as I do!
