The alphabet is large and attractive. Keys for the charts recommend letter colors, but can be changed. Charts are of black and white symbols, and the letters are about the same height, 101 squares high. Ten projects are highlighted - lavender bag, a foot stool, pin cushion, tea towel and a cot quilt. There is a page of British needlecraft suppliers, and a cotton conversion chart (for the colors used) for DMC, Anchor, Coats and Madeira floss.
