The Chinese designs in this booklet are wonderful and cover everything from ideograms to fish to dragons to Asian flowers. Best yet, the patterns are presented as color photographs and line drawings for easy transfer. The line drawings are gridded which makes for easy sizing.All of the patterns are attractive and all are easily reproducible with DMC or other cotton floss. No specific color numbers are provided, but I see this as a positive as it allows the embroiderer to choose their own palette and colorway. I liked this so much that I hope to get a copy of the DMC Yugoslavian embroidery booklet. Recommended to anyone who wishes to reproduce Asian embroidery motifs on clothing or household items.
